

MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

\*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms.

\*Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims.

\*Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or low-income subsidy programs.

\*Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

Note: MMAP counselors are available year round to help you with your Medicare/Medicaid issues.







Senior Project Fresh: Senior Project Fresh is here again. This year, the program has updated how it distributes the dollar amounts to use at the markets and has gone digital. Please contact the senior center if you have questions. You will need either a smartphone or access to an email address and password to sign up.

Senior Project Fresh is a food program that awards credits that are to be used at participating farm markets for fresh produce. There is no cost for this program, but you must be income eligible, signed up to participate, and vendors must be enrolled in the program to redeem the credits.






