I had enrolled in the Weatherization Program after a tenant in my basement apartment had let it flood for weeks without telling me, and it developed a black mold issue. Between the cause of the leak (the water heater for the entire home) and the mold issue, I had very few options. I was directed toward the Weatherization Program and after the intake process my application was accepted.

Shortly after they sent out the inspection team to look over not just the apartment, but the entire house. After an exhaustive examination they went over everything they discovered regarding weatherizing and repairing my home. Black Mold remediation, new insulation in the walls and weatherstripping on the doors and windows, roof repair and more. Given the severity and seriousness of the mold issue in the basement apartment I was told they would have to move swiftly to avoid my home becoming a total loss.

Within about 2 weeks from the inspection, I had contractors in the apartment, removing wet carpeting, taking down drywall and remediating the remaining mold. They even fixed a pipe that burst during the weekend when it got to cold, before they were able to insulate the area it was in. Tim, the contractor, and his crew were amazing!

The roofers had an army of guys and got my oddly shaped roof done about 4 days from the start. It looks great and isn't something I likely would have been able to do on my own for years. Another great group of guys that worked very hard!

I am just very thankful for the Weatherization Program and those that they contracted with. They literally saved my home, my family and myself from a dire situation. Thank you, Brenda, Joe, Sherri and Ellie, you have all been fantastic and I can't even put into words how much this means to me.
