MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

\*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms.

\*Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims.

\*Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or low-income subsidy programs.

\*Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

#### MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIOD ENDING ON DECEMBER 7th.

For those who are looking at changing up your drug plan, or switching to a Medicare Advantage plan for 2024, your deadline may be soon. December 7th is the last day to make changes to your drug plan, or enroll into a Medicare Advantage plan for 2024.

Comparing drug plans can save you money on premiums, and copays at the pharmacy. It only take a little bit of time to look into your options, but can save you plenty in 2024.

If you still need an appointment, do not wait. Call your local MMAP counselor to schedule today.

#### Pecan Cranberry Cheeseball

Cheese ball ingredients: 2–8oz packages of cream cheese 1 cup dried cranberries (Craisins) chopped 1/2 cup (2-3) sliced green onions



1 cup (4oz) shredded white cheddar cheese

Coating ingredients:

1/3 cup chopped pecans\*

1/3 dried cranberries (chopped)

1/3 up fresh chopped parsley (or finely sliced green onions)

Directions: Using an electric mixer, beat the cream cheese with the dried cranberries and green onions. Add the shredded cheddar cheese and mix to incorporate.

Scrape mixture out onto a piece of plastic wrap. Cover and shape into a ball or log. Refrigerate for at least an hour or more for it to slightly firm up.

Once it firms up, or when you are ready to serve, combine the coating ingredients and place onto a large plate. Remove the plastic, and then roll the ball or log in the coating until completely covered. You can serve immediately with crackers, or place in the fridge overnight to allow for more flavor. Keep refrigerated.

\*Toasting your pecans will give it a little more dimension. Place shopped pecans on a lined baking sheet and bake for 5 min at 375 degrees to toast.




