Medicare Minutes

MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms.

*Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims.

*Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or low-income subsidy programs.

*Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

HOMESTEAD & HOME HEATING CREDITS:

We are still accepting appointments for your Home Heating and Homestead Credits. Your deadline to file these credits are not April 15th. Only Federal and State taxable credit filers need to file by April 15th to avoid any penalty etc. These credits are from the State of Michigan, and are available if you qualify based on your net income after any insurance premiums are deducted. If you think you may qualify, or have questions, please call the center to schedule a free tax appointment.



Menominee CSFP Program

CSFP commodity distribution takes place bi-monthly in Menominee County every third Tuesday. The next distribution for Menominee Senior Center is set for 11 am-noon on Tuesday, May 21. This will take place in the parking lot on 11th Avenue behind the Holy Spirit Church. This is a drive-up distribution.

(For CSFP, you must be age 60 and over and within income guidelines. You will need to certify with the center in advance to qualify.)

Note: Each center has its own dates/times for CSFP distribution. Contact your local center for more details about the CSFP program.

MEDICARE FRAUD-You can prevent it! Each quarter, the Center for Medicare Services

(CMS) mails out a "Medicare Summary Notice".

This form shows you any provider that has asked to bill Medicare for Medicare covered services. It shows what was billed, the Medicare approved amount and what you could be billed for.

Once you receive this, take a moment to look over the claims that were billed to Medicare. They will list the dates, and also what provider has asked Medicare for payment. Compare these dates to your past appointments and procedures to see if this is accurate. If there is a service, date, or provider you did not see, you should always question it.

You have the right to an appeal if you believe there was an error. The appeal process is on the back of the form. But, any MMAP counselor can assist you with filing the appeal.

Why is this so important? You are the first line of defense on catching Medicare Fraud/Waste/Abuse. Sometimes the error is just a billing error, but other times it could be a red flag that some type of fraud or abuse is taking place. The more we can prevent fraud and abuse, the more money is saved, keeping Medicare costs down for all.





MEDICARE MEMO

What will happen during my Annual
Wellness Visit?

The Annual Wellness Visit (AWV) is a yearly appointment with your primary care provider to create or update a personalized prevention plan. Medicare Part B covers the AWV if you have had Part B for over 12 months and you have not received an AWV or your Welcome to Medicare Visit within the last 12 months. At your Annual Wellness Visit, your doctor may:

- ⇒ Check your height, weight, blood pressure, and other routine measurements
- ⇒ Give you a health assessment



- ⇒ Review your functional ability and level of safety
- ⇒ Learn about your medical & family history
- ⇒ Make a list of your current providers, durable medical equipment suppliers and medications
- ⇒ Create a 5-10 year screening schedule
- ⇒ Identify risk factors and current medical & mental health conditions along with related current or recommended treatments
- ⇒ Screen for cognitive impairment, including diseases such as Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia
- ⇒ Screen for depression
- ⇒ Provide health advice and referrals

The AWV is NOT a head to toe physical. Medicare Part B covers the AWV with no cost sharing but depending on your visit, you may be responsible for paying a facility fee or cost sharing on any diagnostic services you receive.
