#### **Medicare Minutes**

MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

\*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms.

\*Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims.

\*Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or low-income subsidy programs.

\*Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

#### **HOMESTEAD & HOME HEATING CREDITS:**

We are still accepting appointments for your Home Heating and Homestead Credits. Your deadline to file these credits are not April 15th. Only Federal and State taxable credit filers need to file by April 15th to avoid any penalty etc. These credits are from the State of Michigan, and are available if you qualify based on your net income after any insurance premiums are deducted. If you think you may qualify, or have questions, please call the center to schedule a free tax appointment.



#### **Menominee CSFP Program**

CSFP commodity distribution takes place bi-monthly in Menominee County every third Tuesday. The next distribution for Menominee Senior Center is set for 11 am-noon on Tuesday, May 21. This will take place in the parking lot on 11th Avenue behind the Holy Spirit Church. This is a drive-up distribution.

(For CSFP, you must be age 60 and over and within income guidelines. You will need to certify with the center in advance to qualify.)

Note: Each center has its own dates/times for CSFP distribution. Contact your local center for more details about the CSFP program.

#### **Recognizing Phone Scams:**

While phone technology is wonderful, there are ways to protect yourself from scams if you know what to look for.

Text scams: "Smishing" Unknown callers that ask you to reply to a text by sending you a link. These scams try to get your information, or perhaps install malware to steal personal information, or rack up charges that you did not seek. They sometimes act like an account you already have to get you to think you are dealing with the actual business, and it is not. Banks, IRS, and reputable companies do not use this method of contact or ask for your sensitive information via text. Your best bet to know if there is an issue is to find the actual business number and call them directly. The most popular text scams come from USPS, PayPal, Amazon, and Netflix. So, please be wary if you have those accounts that it may not be them trying to contact you.

You can report scam attempts to your wireless service provider by forwarding unwanted text to 7726 or "spam".

If you think you have been a victim of a texting scam, and you have given out personal information, report it immediately to your local law enforcement agency and notify your service provider and any financial institutions where you have accounts.






